

Why Use an Acid Detergent?



Maintain Surface Finish

A rough surface finish is susceptible to potential corrosion, bacterial attachment, and biofilm formation on equipment components and associated piping.



Improve Cleanability

Rouge on surfaces can make surfaces more difficult to clean by preventing cleaning agent contact with underlying residues or soils.



Prevent Microbial Excursions

A poor cleaning regime can lead to multi-species Biofilm:

Ralstonia pickettii
Pseudomonas fluorescens
Bacille non revivifiable
Burkholderia cepacia



Avoid Product Contamination

The presence of rouge or the presence of a bacterial contamination due to rouge can ultimately impact the product being produced and can potentially adulterate the product.
